## **Ash Wednesday 14th February**

Ash Wednesday begins the 40 days of Lent, a time when we remember that Jesus spent 40 days in the desert fasting and resisting temptation. The day before Ash Wednesday, known by many as "Shrove Tuesday" or "Fat Tuesday", is a chance to feast and indulge — maybe even eat a pancake or two. We do this in preparation of our own fasting on Ash Wednesday and throughout Lent. Usually, the Ash Wednesday ashes are created by burning palms from the previous year's Palm Sunday celebration. Palm Sunday is the last Sunday of Lent and leads into Holy Week. It is on this day that people laid palms to cover Jesus's path as he arrived in Jerusalem, just days before he was crucified.

The ashes symbolize our mortality – "Remember you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

#### **Book Club**

Last year we had an enjoyable time reading then discussing books we had chosen. Mostly they took us into the lives of interesting people, which caused much reflection within our group.
