Tuesday 21 September 2010

There was a small attendance at this month's meeting because of the weather conditions. The Hospital Chaplaincy Appeal envelopes will now be a week later.

Ministry in 2011 Rev Donald Phillips reported that so far no arrangements have been made for ministry supply next year.

Finances Murray Farley reported that there was a small credit of \$319 in our accounts for the two months July and August. This was to be expected, as we are not now paying the full ministry stipend.

GST Our rental charges for the centre will be increased from 1 October.

Electricity Charges We have agreed to join with the Dunedin Mission and Methodist churches in Otago to have a bulk electricity purchase contract.

Thanks (a) Donald expressed his appreciation of the on-going sterling work of the members of the Pastoral Committee with their visiting, their general support and the ways in which they just keep in touch with people.

(b) The group who rang around the congregation on Saturday, to cancel the service last Sunday were thanked. They were successful, because no one arrived for worship!

It includes the sculpture "Unity" by Star which was donated to us by Rata House earlier this year. It will be returned to us at Lindisfarne next month.
