Our Brown Bags are one-off emergency food parcels which are requested through agencies such as Women's Refuge, Family Start, Family Works. The case-workers from those agencies vet the clients, request a bag, collect and deliver it. We do not know who gets the bags – we know only that it is, for example, for 1 adult and 3 children.
