## Gas Detection Alarm

Because of a problem discovered a few weeks ago, a gas detection alarm has been installed in the kitchen. Please be aware that ...

The alarm will emit a high-pitched noise, similar to a smoke alarm.

The noise will only come from the alarm in the kitchen, and may only be heard softly in other parts of the building. If a noise is heard and upon investigation it is determined the alarm is coming from the kitchen, please do not enter and treat it as an emergency.

If the alarm activates, please follow normal emergency procedures. Evacuate the building and call 111. Do not re-enter the building until Fire and Emergency NZ have investigated and given the building the all clear.
