Thought for the Week

Humility flows through today's readings, even the celebrative entry into Jerusalem. The path of a joyful parade quickly turned into the Via Dolorosa, reminding us that humility is perhaps the wisest and most difficult guide on any journey. Walking gently and humbly on the journey into Jerusalem, Jesus rode a colt among a crowd that celebrated and honoured him. With this same humility, Jesus gathered with his disciples in servanthood and compassion, faced his accusers, and hung on a cross with criminals. But today, we focus not on the end of the journey, but the entry into Jerusalem at the beginning of holy week. Everything is here—humbleness and triumph—foreshadowing the mystery of death and resurrection yet to come.
